Parks & Recreation

Coalinga Mineral Springs Recreation Area is located 18 miles west of Coalinga off Highway 198 on Coalinga Mineral Springs Road. It became a Fresno County Park in 1967 when a thirty-year lease agreement was signed with the Wildlife Conservation Board, to provide hunting and hiking access to BLM lands. Consisting of 35 acres, this park provides day use as well as overnight camping facilities. Restrooms, picnic sites, and BBQ pits are available.
